Exam Policy for Trainees

The Pediatric Postgraduate Medical Education Program will cover the costs of the Royal College mock OSCE, MCQ and SAQ examinations as well as the cost of the Royal College Assessment of History and Physical Examination Skills in Pediatrics – Part I (long case examinations) for trainees in the Pediatric Postgraduate Medical Education Program at McMaster University. This includes residents in the program and residents in fellowship programs (up to PGY5 year) who completed their core residency training in the Pediatric Postgraduate Medical Education Program at McMaster University. If a resident transfers out of the program at any time during their training to another university, examinations will be the responsibility of their new home base program. Costs will also be covered for residents who were unsuccessful in their exams for a further one-year. All other trainees require approval from the Program Director of the Pediatric Postgraduate Medical Education Program to participate in any of the above noted examinations as well as exam preparation sessions and will be charged the following fee as applicable. Payment is to be made by cheque payable to McMaster University and sent to the Pediatric Postgraduate Medical Education at McMaster University prior to the date of the examination.
